

Brief history of the ICT Society of St. Peter's College

The roots of formal Computer Education at St. Peter's College date back to 1992, when a Computer Awareness Course was introduced for Year 4 and above during the school vacation. At the same time, senior students began providing software services to external organizations under the guidance of Mr. Dep Weerasinghe, a British-qualified programmer. This initiative was further strengthened when the Old Boys' Union (London Branch) sponsored five computers and a printer, laying the foundation for the College's first Computer Centre.

The ICT Club was officially inaugurated in 1997 and has since grown significantly from its humble beginnings. Over the years, its members have actively participated in numerous ICT-related competitions and quizzes organized by schools and institutions across the country.

The ICT Society has also contributed greatly to the College community through projects such as formatting and upgrading school laptops, as well as developing innovative digital solutions. At present, the ICT Society functions under the guidance of the Rector of St. Peter's College, Rev. Fr. Rohitha Rodrigo, who serves as Priest-in-Charge, with Mr. Krishan Chanaka as Master-in-Charge. The leadership team is headed by Mast. Sunderesan Yohisaai as President.
