Competition Rules and Regulations

Common Rules

1. Detailed judging criteria of each competition will be shared via WhatsApp group after registration.
2. All participants who will be taking part in Physical competitions must be present **on 25th of August 2025** at St. Peter's College **from 2:00 pm onwards**.
3. The competitions will be **divided into the following two groups** –
 - **Grades 6 – 9**
 - **Grades 10 – 13**

Physical Competitions

1. Quiz Competition

- Participants **compete in teams of 4 members all belonging in the same student category as mentioned below** –
 - **Grades 6 – 8**
 - **Grades 9 – 11**
 - **Grades 10 – 13**
- Teams are expected to maintain respectful behaviour and avoid any form of cheating or unethical conduct. Violations may lead to disqualification.
- This competition will be comprised under the following topics in relation to the theme of the ICT Day **“Digital Identity” – Online Presence and Reputation, Privacy and Security, Digital Footprint, Cyber Ethics and Responsibility, Authentication and Access Management**.
- **Preliminary Round:**
 - **Format** –
 - **30 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)**, covering a broad spectrum of General ICT knowledge and initial concepts related to Digital Identity.
 - **Total Time:** Strict time limit of 30 seconds per MCQ, promoting rapid decision-making with a **total duration of 20 minutes**.
 - **Points** – Each correct answer will carry 1 point, with a maximum total of 30 points.



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- The two teams with the highest scores from Preliminary Round will advance to the Final Round which will be held on the ICT Day. Further details will be shared with them accordingly.

2. Presentation Competition

- “You Are What You Click: Understanding your Digital Footprint” is the chosen topic for this competition.
- Each team must consist of **2 – 4 members, all belonging to the same student category.**
- Each team will be given a time of 10 – 12 minutes to present their presentation.
- The presentation must be submitted in PPTX format to the following website **on or before 25th of August 2025** under the following name.

- Presentations must be original and created from scratch. Use of templates is not allowed.
- All teams will be evaluated by a panel of judges and their decision will be final.

Online Competitions

1. E-Sports Competition

- This competition is open to all individuals (**Except** for the game ‘**Valorant**’ which needs a team consisting a **minimum of 5 players**).
- The following games will be played in this competition
 - **Rocket League**
 - **Valorant**
 - **Clash Royale**
- All gameplay will be heavily monitored, any type of **cheating and exploiting** will result in an immediate disqualification.
- Further details will be provided via the WhatsApp group after registration.



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2. Graphic Designing Competition

- This is an individual competition and is open to students who would love to showcase their abilities.
- The **deadline** for uploading your creations is on the **27th of August 2025** and they must be uploaded via the website link - www.peteriteict.com/
- All submitted artworks must be the **original creation** of the participant.
- Any form of plagiarism or unauthorized use of copyright material will result in immediate disqualification; while inspiration is allowed, direct copying or tracing is strictly prohibited.
- Use of AI-generated images/elements is **not allowed**.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to request original project files (Ex:- .psd, .ai, .blend) for verification purposes.
- Artwork must be appropriate for a school environment.
- This competition requires participants to design a Digital Art that clearly relates to the competition's theme **"Digital Identity"**. In relation to that the participants can design under the following topics:
 - "Digital Art Concepts":
Focus: Data trails, abstract representations of information flow, digital dust, layered data, fragmented images representing privacy concerns.
 - "Digital Citizen: Rights and Responsibilities":
Focus: The ethical dimensions of online life – respect, empathy, online etiquette, and intellectual property.
 - "The Future of Digital Identity":
Focus: Speculating on how emerging technologies will shape our future digital selves.
- **Recommended Software:** Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, GIMP
- Further details regarding submission and technical requirements will be shared through the WhatsApp group that will be created after registration.



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3. Web Designing Competition

- The competition is open to all individuals.
- All projects must be designed under the theme “**Digital Identity**”.
- Your website (HTML File) and relevant files must be compressed into a .zip folder and renamed accordingly.

File Name:- Web_Designing_(Student Category)_(Participant's name)

Example:- Web_Designing_(6-8)_(Aaron Fernando)

- The zip folder must be uploaded to the website link - <https://www.peteriteict.com/> on or before **27th of August 2025**.
- Use of Programmes and websites like **Canva, Wix** are strictly **PROHIBITED**.
- Code must be clean, well-commented, and valid HTML.
- Submissions should be compatible with the latest versions of major browsers (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge).
- Projects should be responsive and functional on the desktop.
- Further submission and technical details will be shared through the WhatsApp group that will be created after registration.

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
